Tailoring HIV and STD testing for high risk populations out of care

Screening for HIV in Quebec and Canada

Up to 26% of HIV+ people in Canada ignore their HIV status.

In Quebec :

- 15% of HIV+ MSM ignore their HIV status
- 4/10 tested with HIV+ had not been tested in the last 12 months
- 60% late diagnostics

Actuel sur Rue's Mission



- 1. To be an open door toward global and adapted cares for all individuals**

- 2. To promote (re)integration into care for...**
 - groups at high risk for HIV

 - individuals who are vulnerable for STI's and who lost touch with the health care system

L'Actuel sur Rue

HIV and STI checkpoint for people at risk or out of care in the heart of the Montreal gay village

Linkage to care with clinic l'Actuel

Free, walk-in, confidential clinic opened in July 2012

Although supervised by a medical director, no physician works on site.

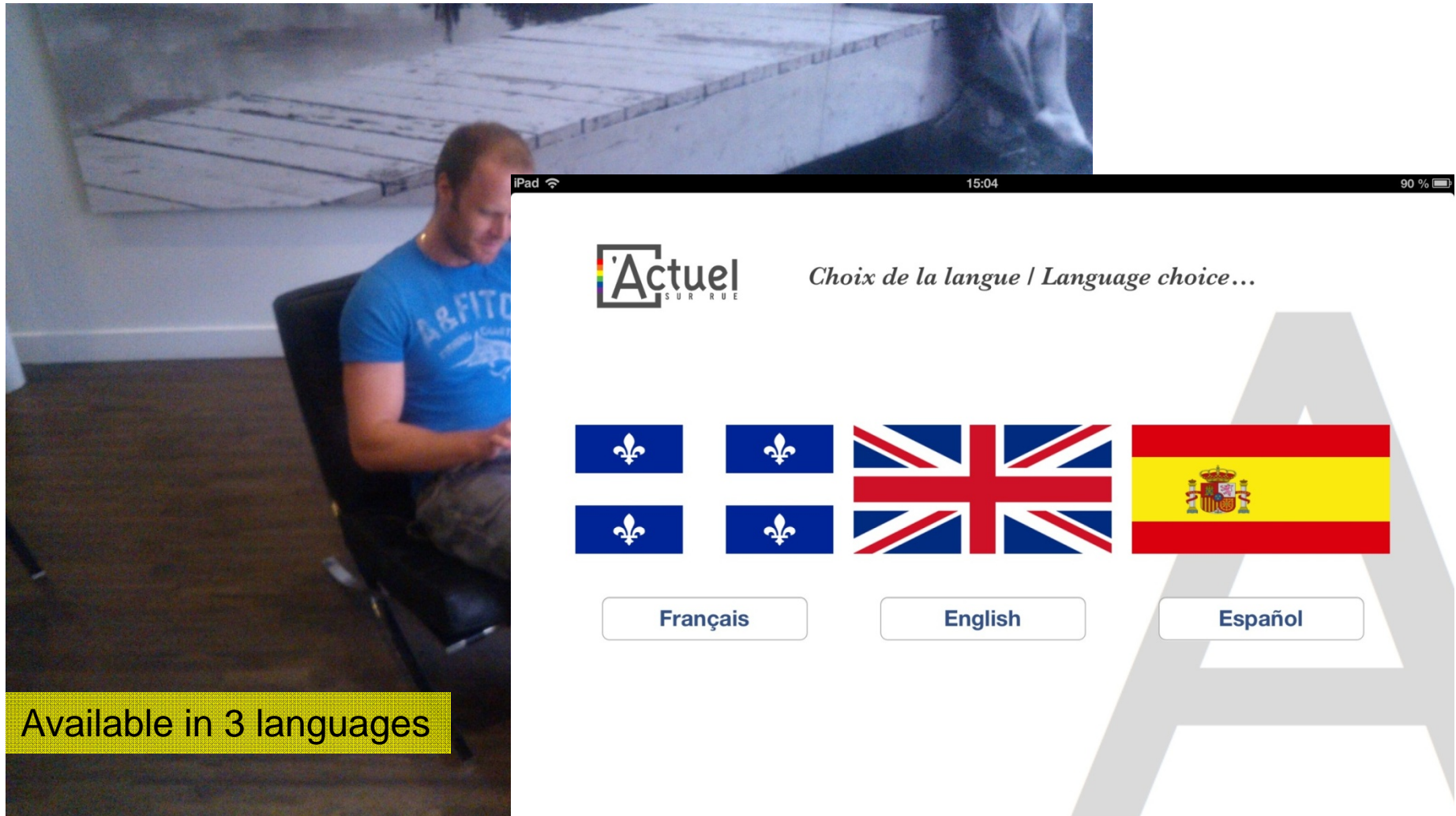
Staff consists of a community agent and a nurse working as a team.

Pre-test evaluation with community agent



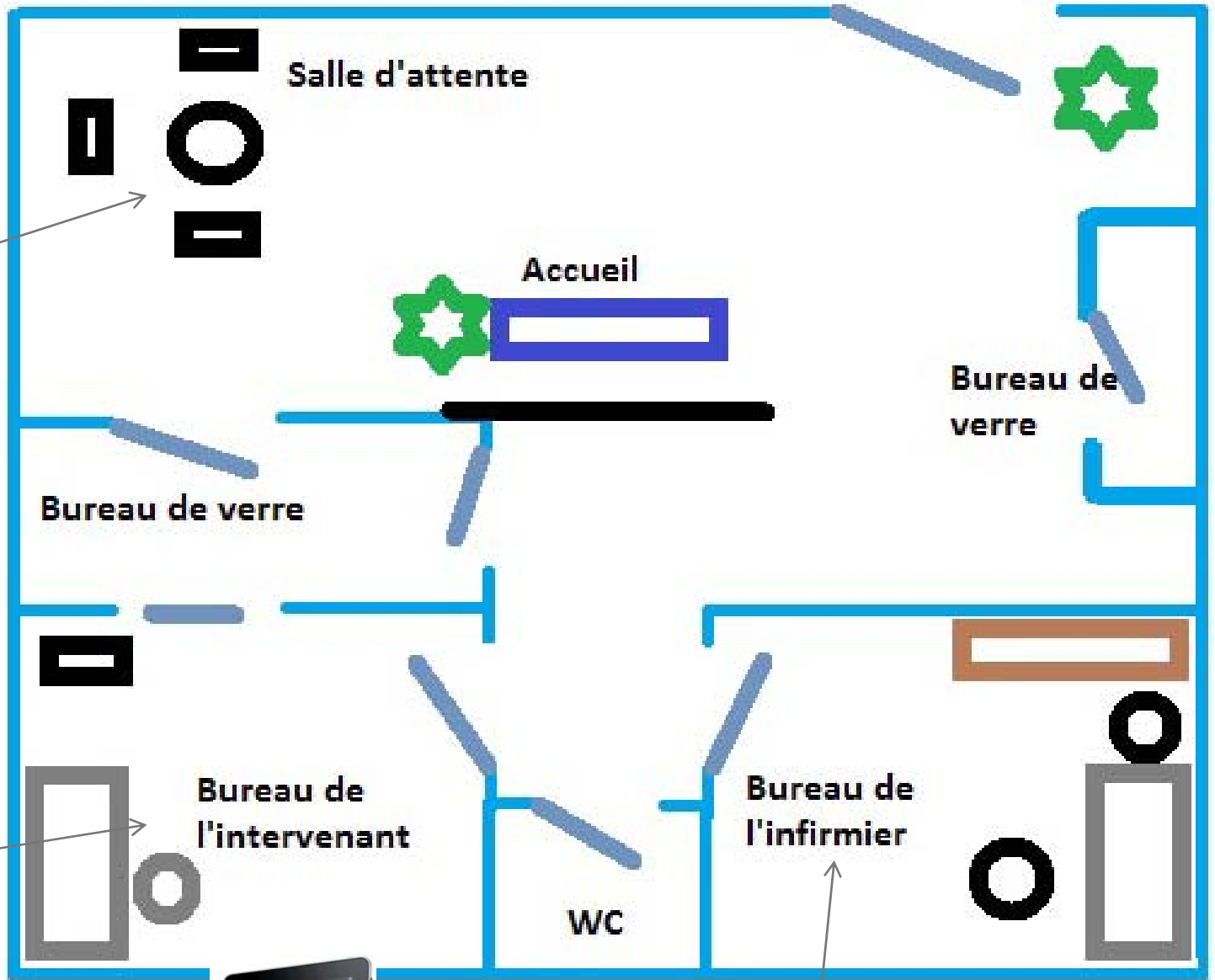
Community agent evaluates participants' needs, questions and the sexual risks.

Self-administered questionnaire filled by participant in the waiting room.
