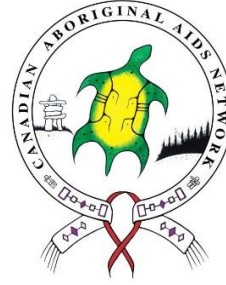

- *Strong Medicine* is an educational video about HIV treatment, health and wellness for Indigenous people living with HIV, their communities, and their care providers.
