1 Background

2 Location and Attendance

In total there were 9 Immigrant Health and Hepatitis C workshops delivered across Canada, reaching 245 people.

3 Methodology

Evaluation forms were distributed to workshop attendees. Appendix A contains the English evaluation form for the Immigrant Health and Hepatitis C workshop and Appendix B contains the evaluation form for the Service Provider Workshop.

Evaluation forms were collected by CATIE staff at the end of each workshop. The data was entered into separate excel spreadsheets and analyzed by language.

Frequency descriptives were produced to summarize the outcomes. The results (in tabulated form) are contained in Appendix C for all the Immigrant Health workshops combined; Appendix D for Immigrant Health workshops presented in Urdu; Appendix E for workshops presented in Punjabi; Appendix F for workshops presented in Mandarin; and Appendix G for the Service Provider workshop.

The qualitative results for the Immigrant Health workshops and the Service Provider workshop can be found in Appendices H and I respectively.

4 Evaluation Results

Immigrant Health and Hepatitis C Workshop

184 Immigrant Health and Hepatitis C evaluation forms were completed by 245 attendees resulting in a 75% response rate.

Relevance:

- 95% thought the workshop was useful or very useful.
- 98% were satisfied or very satisfied with the workshop.
- 98% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was appropriate for them.
- 77% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was relevant to them or the work that they do.
- 97% agreed or strongly agreed that they would recommend the workshop to others.

Key Evaluation Statistics:

- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was well presented.
- 98% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop presenter was knowledgeable about the topic being discussed.
- 97% agreed or strongly agreed that they will use/apply the knowledge gained at the workshop in their life.
- 99% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their capacity to respond to hepatitis C within their community/personal life.
- 99% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their knowledge of hepatitis C.
- 64% reported that the level of the workshop for their experience level was 'about right'. 20% felt it was 'too basic' and 17% thought it was 'too advanced'.

On average workshop participants rated their knowledge of hepatitis C at 5.4 on a scale of 1 (no knowledge) to 10 (expert knowledge) before the workshop. This increased to 8.5 after the workshop – this increase is statistically significant (p<0.01). Seventy-five percent of respondents reported an increase in knowledge based on this scale.

Service Provider Workshop

18 Service Provider Workshop evaluation forms were completed by 19 attendees resulting in a 95% response rate.

Relevance:

- 94% thought the workshop was useful or very useful.
- 100% were satisfied or very satisfied with the workshop.
- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was appropriate for them.
- 89% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was relevant to the work that they do.
- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that they would recommend the workshop to their coworkers.

Key Evaluation Statistics:

- 84% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was well presented.
- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop presenter was knowledgeable about the topic being discussed.
- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that they will use/apply the knowledge gained at the workshop in their work.
- 82% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their capacity to respond to hepatitis C within their community/personal life.
- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their knowledge of hepatitis
 C.
- 100% reported that the level of the workshop for their experience level was 'about right'.

On average workshop participants rated their knowledge of hepatitis C at 4.8 on a scale of 1 (no knowledge) to 10 (expert knowledge) before the workshop. This increased to 8.1 after the workshop – this increase is statistically significant (p<0.01). Ninety-four percent of respondents reported an increase in knowledge based on this scale.

5 Conclusion

The workshop evaluations for both the Immigrant Health and Service Provider workshops were overwhelmingly positive.

Are the Immigrant Health and Hepatitis C workshops relevant?

CATIE collects key information to ascertain if the workshops are relevant to our stakeholders.

Overall these workshops are extremely relevant.

- 95% of workshop attendees reported the workshop was useful for them.
- 98% of workshop attendees were satisfied or very satisfied with the workshop.

- 98% of workshop attendees agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was appropriate for them.
- 77% of workshop attendees agree or strongly agreed that the workshop was relevant to them.
- 97% of workshop attendees agreed or strongly agreed that they would recommend the workshop to others.

Are the Immigrant Health and Hepatitis C workshops effective?

CATIE collects key information to ascertain if the Hepatitis C workshops are meeting their objectives. Overall, CATIE's workshops have been shown to be very effective.

Objective 1: Increase knowledge and awareness of the nature of Hepatitis C and other infections

- 99% of workshop attendees agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their knowledge of hepatitis C.
- Based on a 10 point rating scale the average knowledge of participants increased from
 5.4 to 8.5; 75% of participants reported an increase in knowledge based on this 10 point scale.

Objective 2: Increase organizational and individual capacity to support people living with and at risk for hepatitis C.

- 97% of workshop participants agreed or strongly agreed they will use/apply the knowledge gained at the workshop in their work/life.
- 99% of workshop participants agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their capacity to respond to hepatitis C within their communities/personal life.

Are the Service Provider workshops relevant?

CATIE collects key information to ascertain if the workshops are relevant to our stakeholders.

Overall these workshops are extremely relevant.

- 94% of workshop attendees reported the workshop was useful for them.
- 100% of workshop attendees were satisfied or very satisfied with the workshop.
- 100% of workshop attendees agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop was appropriate for them.
- 89% of workshop attendees agree or strongly agreed that the workshop was relevant to them.

• 100% of workshop attendees agreed or strongly agreed that they would recommend the workshop to their coworkers.

Are the Service Provider workshops effective?

CATIE collects key information to ascertain if the workshops are meeting their objectives. Overall, CATIE's workshops have been shown to be very effective.

Objective 1: Increase knowledge and awareness of the nature of Hepatitis C and other infections

- 100% of workshop attendees agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their knowledge of hepatitis C.
- Based on a 10 point rating scale the average knowledge of participants increased from 4.8 to 8.1; 94% of participants reported an increase in knowledge based on this 10 point scale.

Objective 2: Increase organizational and individual capacity to support people living with and at risk for hepatitis C.

- 100% of workshop participants agreed or strongly agreed they will use/apply the knowledge gained at the workshop in their work/life.
- 82% of workshop participants agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop increased their capacity to respond to hepatitis C within their communities/personal life.
