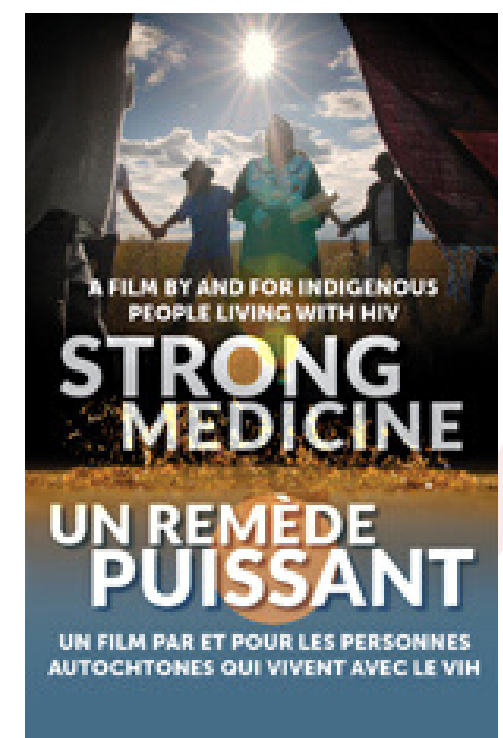
"What's Your Story?" An Interactive Learning Event
